- These are tiny worms in your child's poo. They're common in children and can spread easily.
- A pharmacist can help with threadworms. You can buy medicine for threadworms from pharmacies such as Kingsfold Pharmacy. This is usually a chewable tablet or liquid you swallow.
- It is important to treat everyone in your household, even if they don't have symptoms.

Again school will be reiterating the need for children to regularly wash their hands.
